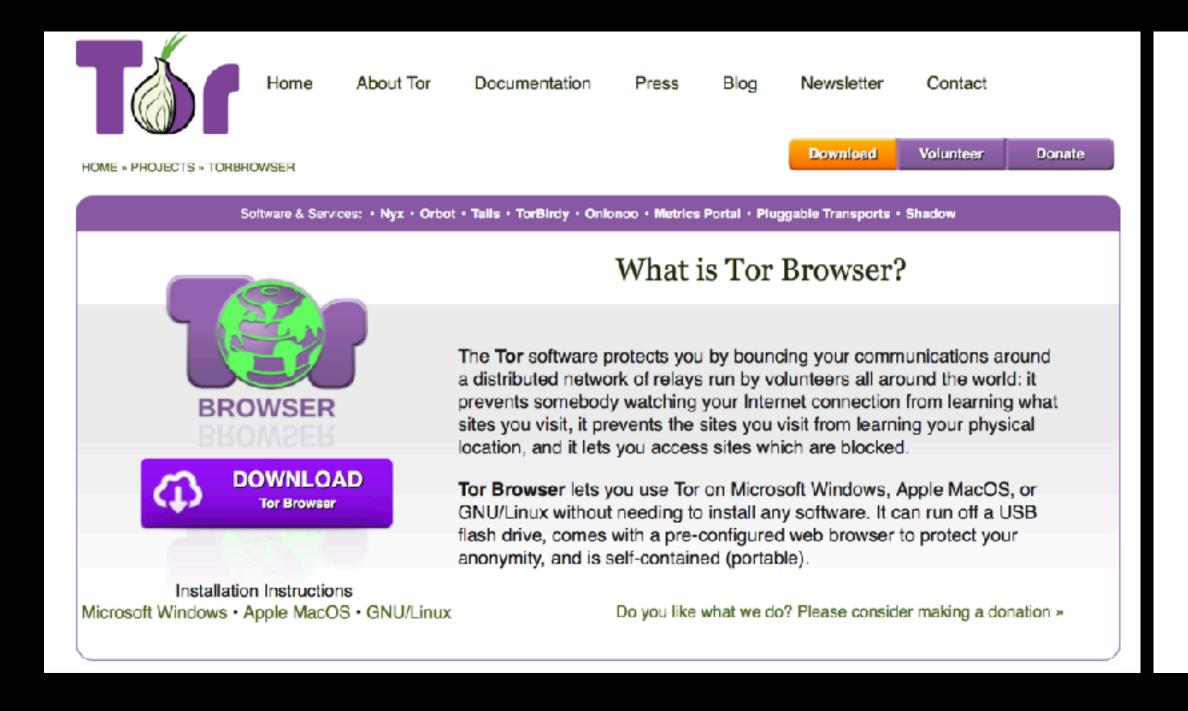


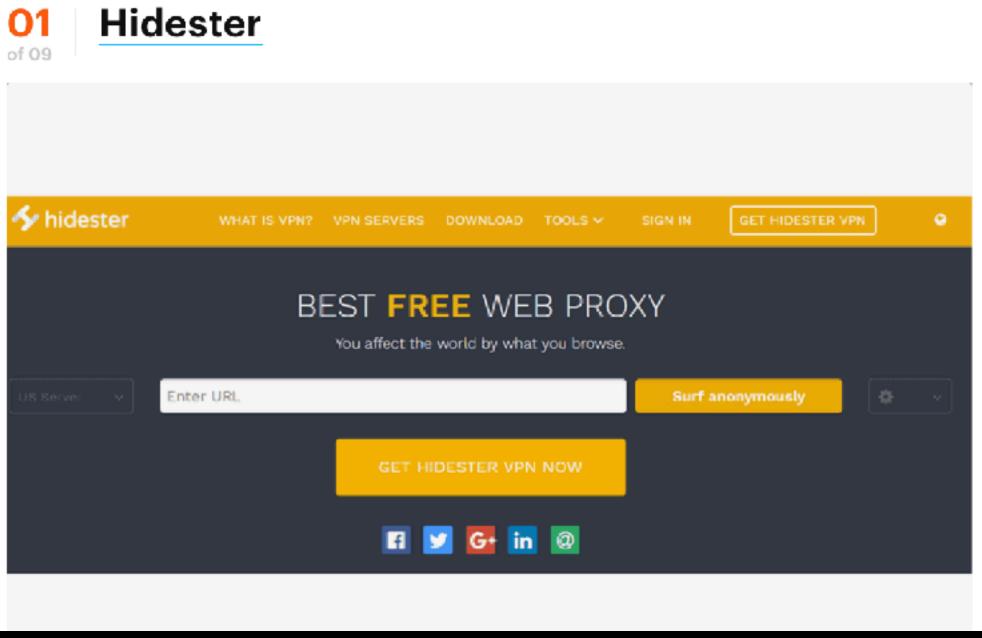




You Can be Proactive (Paranoid?)

- or at least be aware and not give things up willingly











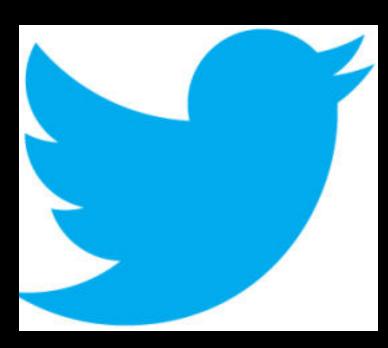

What Can We Do?

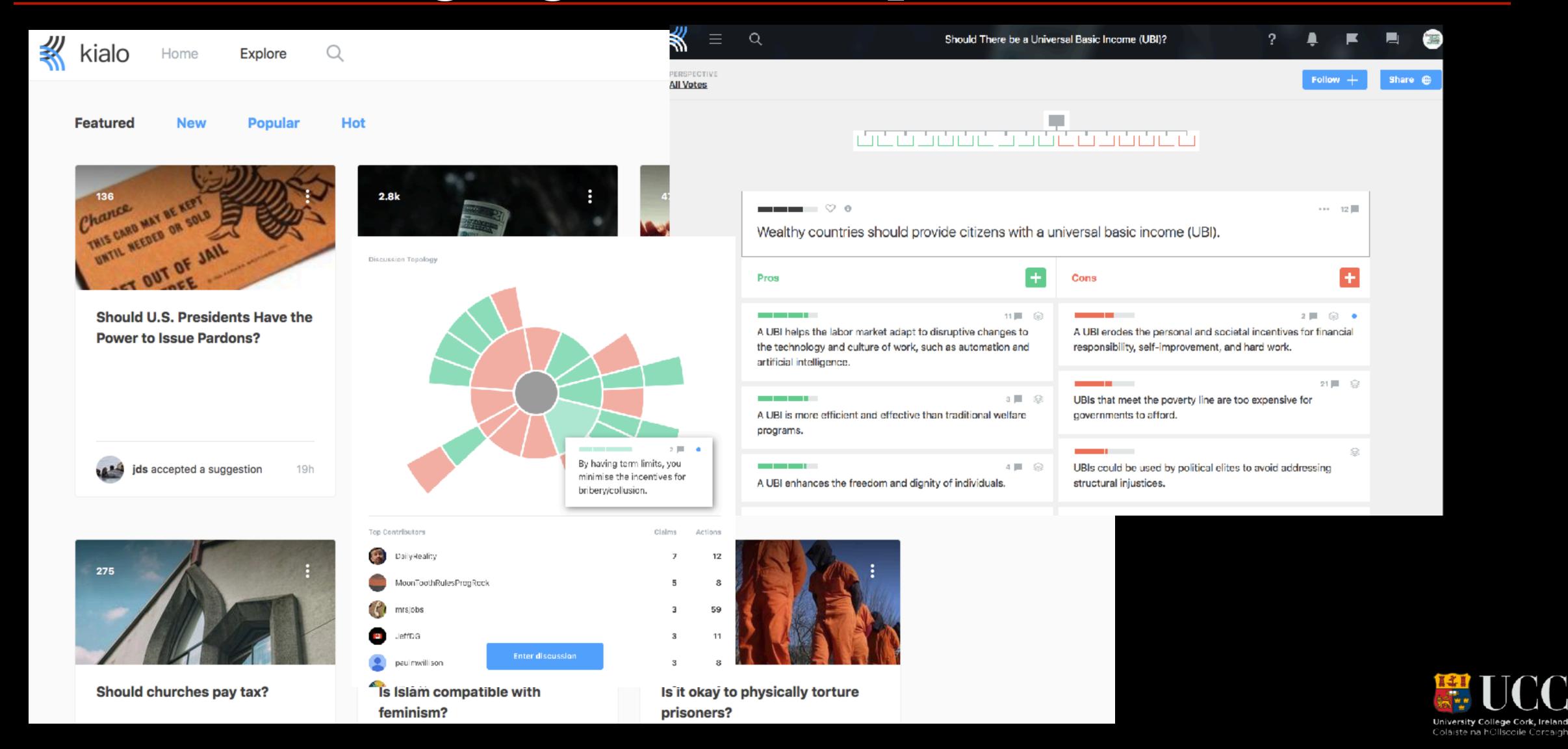

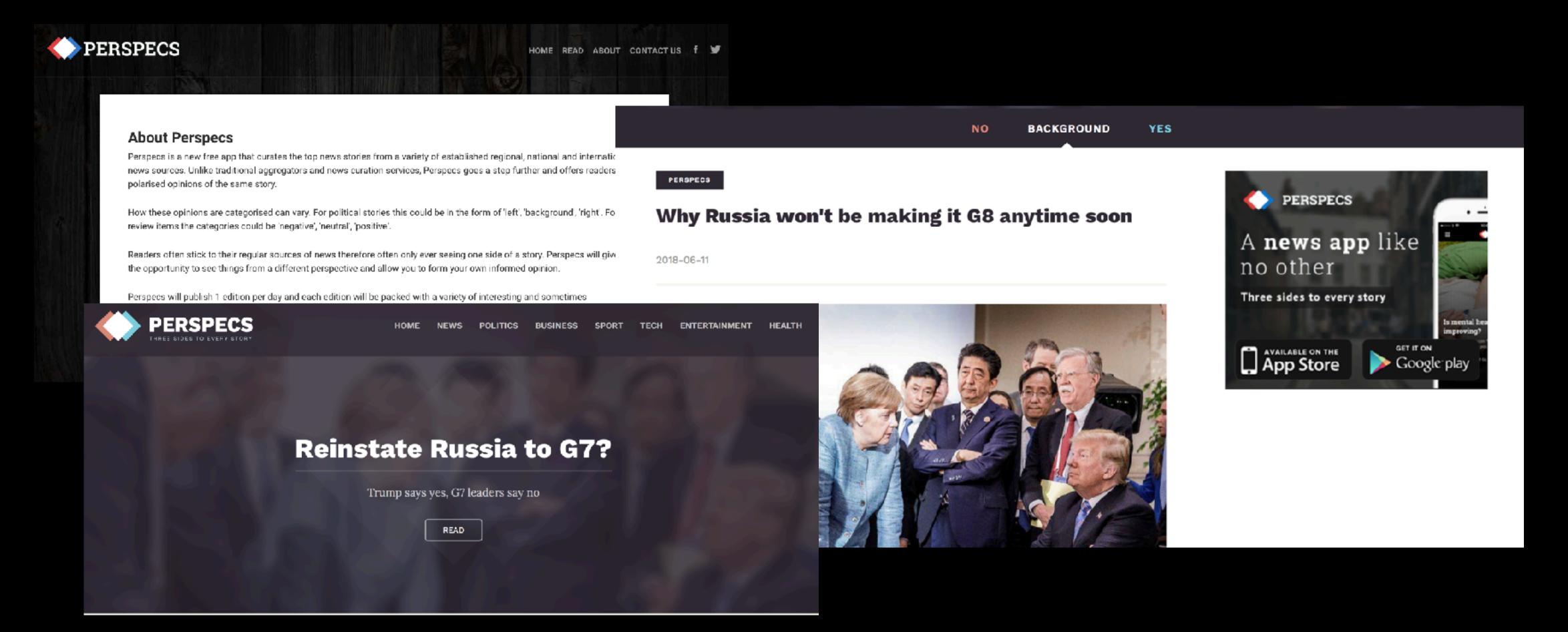

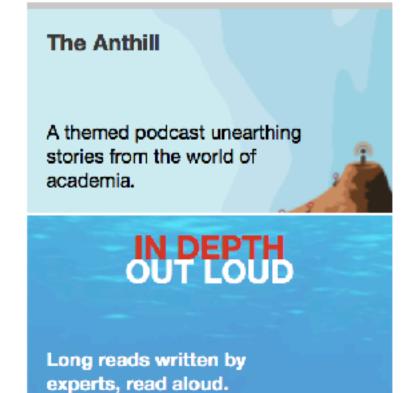
